



A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI'S ORDINANCE TO ADOPT MILITARY COMPATIBILITY AREA OVERLAY DISTRICTS FOR THE AREAS OF AND SURROUNDING TRUAX FIELD AT NAVAL AIR STATION - CORPUS CHRISTI, NAVAL AUXILIARY LANDING FIELD CABANISS, AND NAVAL AUXILIARY LANDING FIELD WALDRON TO MAKE LAND USE COMPATIBLE WITH NAVAL AIR STATION - CORPUS CHRISTI'S MILITARY MISSION.

WHEREAS, IT IS WIDELY KNOWN THE UNITED CORPUS CHRISTI CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IS IN BOLD SUPPORT OF THE NAVY AND ALL THE MILITARY MISSIONS OF SOUTH TEXAS; AND

WHEREAS, NAVAL AIR STATION - CORPUS CHRISTI (NAS-CC) AND ITS TENANTS, INCLUDING THE CORPUS CHRISTI ARMY DEPOT (CCAD) ARE ESSENTIAL ECONOMIC ANCHORS IN OUR LOCAL ECONOMY AND GENERATES A COMBINED ECONOMIC IMPACT OF OVER \$4 BILLION EACH YEAR; AND

WHEREAS, NAS-CC AND CCAD ARE INEXORABLY LINKED AND THE LOSS OF THE NAVY MISSION WOULD MEAN THE LOSS OF THE CCAD MISSION; AND

WHEREAS, THE NAVY CONSIDERS ENCROACHMENT TO BE THE NUMBER ONE THREAT TO ITS MISSION IN SOUTH TEXAS; AND

WHEREAS, THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI HAS A LONG HISTORY OF PROTECTING THE NAVY'S MISSION FROM ENCROACHMENT WITH ZONING ORDINANCES INCLUDING THE AIR INSTALLATION COMPATIBILITY USE ZONES (AICUZ) WHICH ARE DESIGNED TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF CIVILIANS AND MILITARY PERSONNEL BY ENCOURAGING LAND USE THAT IS COMPATIBLE WITH AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS, TO REDUCE NOISE IMPACTS CAUSED BY AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS, WHILE MEETING OPERATIONAL, TRAINING, AND FLIGHT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS, BOTH ON AND IN THE VICINITY OF INSTALLATIONS, TO INFORM THE PUBLIC AND SEEK COOPERATIVE EFFORTS TO MINIMIZE NOISE AND AIRCRAFT ACCIDENT POTENTIAL IMPACTS BY PROMOTING COMPATIBLE DEVELOPMENT, AND TO PROTECT INSTALLATION INVESTMENTS BY SAFEGUARDING THE INSTALLATION'S OPERATIONAL CAPABILITIES; AND
